

Volunteer Youth Coaching Code of Conduct

All coaches affiliated with Swift Sportsdome youth programs must be familiar with and adhere to the rules established in each individual sports rule book.

- 1) Head Coaches must be at least 21 years of age. Assistant coaches must be at least 18 years of age or at least three (3) years older than the players they will be coaching.
- 2) All coaches must complete a background check form
- 3) All coaches must submit a coaches code of conduct form

As a volunteer coach, **I AGREE TO:**

- Treat each player, opposing coach, official, parent and league administrator with respect and dignity.
- Coach with the goal of creating a positive learning experience for athletes.
- Conduct my practices and games so that all players have an opportunity to safely improve their skill level through active participation.
- All players get about the same playing time. Our league philosophy includes a promise to get everyone involved and to allow every player to feel like they are an important part of the team. That means rotating positions and giving every kid a chance to make a play.
- Exemplify honesty, integrity, fair play, and sportsmanship regardless of the impact that might have upon the outcome of the competition.
- Avoid the use of alcohol and tobacco products during all league sanctioned practices or games.
